**Questions for Further Reflection**

1. Read Hebrews Psalm 100. Take your time. What stands out to you as you read these texts? Anything about these verses that takes you by surprise?
2. What do you think makes worship “irresistible,” and how have you experienced it personally? Have you ever been stuck in a “sing along” mindset as opposed to a “sing-to” mindset?
3. How do you interpret the phrase “we have a hunger for intimacy with the infinite”? What are ways we can cultivate that intimacy in our worship and daily lives?
4. The sermon mentions that worship is evangelistic—our praise can invite others to see God’s value. How does this idea change the way we think about worship in public spaces?
5. What are some “plush toys” or things of lesser value that you find it challenging to release in order to fully value God? How can we become better at recognizing God’s supreme worth?
