### Questions for Reflection

1. As you read Matthew 19:16-24, what stands out to you as most stunning? Explain why.
2. How does fear influence the way we handle money and possessions? Can you identify any fears that may be shaping your financial decisions?
3. Children are described as vulnerable and completely dependent, traits Jesus encouraged in His followers. How can we cultivate childlike dependence on God in our financial lives?
4. The sermon mentions that "saving brings freedom, hoarding brings fear." How have you experienced this truth in your own life? Can you think of examples when saving or hoarding impacted your spiritual or emotional well-being?
5. The rich young ruler left Jesus sad because he couldn't let go of his possessions. Have you ever experienced a similar moment of resistance in your walk with God? What happened, and how did it affect your faith?
