Our church building reopens for Sunday morning worship this Sunday, August 2! We look forward to seeing many of you. Here are some details about the services.

- **Two services – 8 a.m. in the fellowship hall and 10 a.m. in the sanctuary.**
- **We will wear masks inside the building, except when seated in the fellowship hall or sanctuary.** If you don't have a mask, one will be provided for you at the entrance.
- **No singing**, at least for the first couple of weeks.
- While inside, **please refrain from physical contact** (hugging, handshakes, etc.) with those outside your immediate family. Outside the building, please do not engage in physical contact without first receiving permission from the other person.
- **6-foot social distancing rule.** Seating will be spaced appropriately.
- **No nursery staffing.** Parents may take their children to the nursery if needed. Please place any toys your child plays within the Used Toys bin for cleaning.
- After using the restroom, wipe down any surfaces you have touched with the wipes that are provided.
- Prepackaged Communion elements; no passing of offering plates or attendance books.
- Sermon outlines and other materials will be emailed ahead of time and are available at www.efmc.org/reopen.

Those who do not feel safe with the above protocols will have two alternatives.

- The 10:00am service will be streamed live on our website www.efmc.org/stream. You can also stream directly from the Emmanuel Free Methodist Church YouTube channel.
- The 10:00am service will be broadcast on FM 93.1 to the parking lot, allowing people to listen to the service while in their vehicles.

Before and after every service, the building will be cleaned and sanitized. As time passes, we hope to return to more normal patterns. But we're glad to be able to begin now!
